

The Ninth Circuit Library System serves the information needs of circuit, district, bankruptcy and magistrate judges, as well as other court units. The library system consists of 20 staffed libraries which include the San Francisco headquarters library and 19 branch libraries located throughout the Circuit.

Court libraries may make their collections available to members of the bar and the general public subject to local court rules. The Headquarters Library, located on the first floor of the US Court of Appeals at 95 Seventh Street in San Francisco, is open to the public Monday-Friday 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during court week.
