basis that she failed to demonstrate the requisite hardship to her United States citizen child. Petitioner contends that she met the hardship requirement of 8 U.S.C. § 1229b(b)(1)(D). We lack jurisdiction to review the agency's discretionary hardship determination. *See* 8 U.S.C. § 1252(a)(2)(B)(i); *Martinez-Rosas v. Gonzales*, 424 F.3d 926, 929-30 (9th Cir. 2005).
