Upon review of the record and appellant's opening brief, this court hereby summarily affirms the district court's order denying appellant's motion for preliminary injunctive relief. *See United States v. Hooton*, 693 F.2d 857 (9th Cir. 1982) (per curiam) (summary affirmance appropriate where result is clear from face of record); *see also Gregorio T. v. Wilson*, 59 F.3d 1002, 1004-05 (9th Cir. 1995) (denial of preliminary injunctive relief reviewed for abuse of discretion).
