Kimberly Hetrick appeals the district court's denial of her motion to  
suppress marijuana found in the panels of her car as she attempted to cross the

border into the United States. We have jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1291, and we affirm. We grant the Government's unopposed motion to supplement the record on appeal.

*United States v. Camacho*<sup>1</sup> controls. As in that case, nothing in the record suggests that the Buster posed any danger to the defendant or her vehicle.<sup>2</sup>

AFFIRMED.
